## Shared Shuttle Service (Most Common & Cost-Effective)

This is the most popular choice for individual travelers. These shuttle companies offer frequent, scheduled departures from the Calgary, International Airport to Banff. We highly recommend booking your spot in advance to ensure availability:

## Rental Car

A rental car gives you the freedom to explore the area at your leisure. Please remember that all vehicles entering Banff National Park require a park pass, and the hotel has a daily fee for parking. Be prepared for potential winter driving conditions in November.

# Hotel Parking Rates

If you are driving, please note that the hotel will charge for parking. The rates are as follows:

**Self-parking:** \$39 CAD per night  
**Valet parking:** \$59 CAD per night  
**Day Visitors (self-parking):** \$15 CAD per hour or \$60 CAD for a full day

## Important Notes

- We highly recommend booking your transportation as early as possible, as November is a popular time for events and the best shuttle times can fill up quickly.
- The trip from the airport to the hotel is approximately 90-120 minutes. Please account for this travel time when booking your flights.
